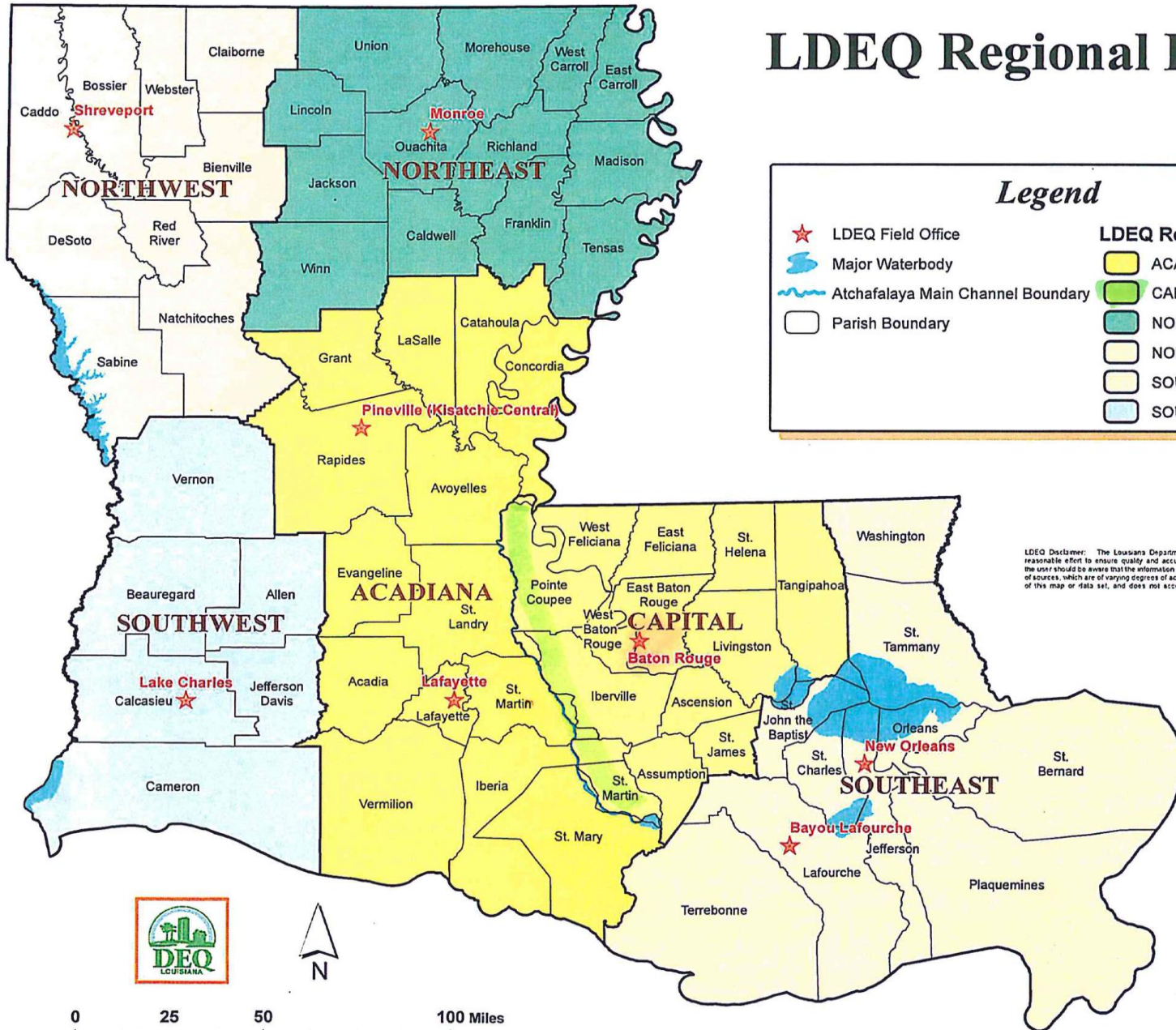

Proper Spill Notifications



LAC 33:I.3915.A.1 - In the event of an unauthorized discharge that does cause an emergency condition, the discharger shall notify the hotline by telephone at (225) 925-6595 immediately, but in no case later than one hour after learning of the discharge.

Proper Spill Notifications



LAC 33:I.3917.A - In the event of an unauthorized discharge which exceeds a reportable quantity...but which does not cause an emergency condition, the discharger shall notify the DPS by telephone at (225)925-6595 within 24 hours after learning of the discharge.

Proper Spill Notifications

LAC 33:I.3915.A.3 - The hotline must be immediately notified of any adverse change in the nature or rate of the discharge.

Proper Spill Notifications



LAC 33:I.3925.A - Written reports for any unauthorized discharge that requires notification shall be submitted by the discharger to the Department in accordance with this section within seven calendar days after the notification...unless otherwise provided for in a valid permit or other division regulations.

Proper Spill Notifications

LAC 33:I.3925.B – Written reports will include, but are not limited to, the following:



Caller information

Discharger information

Dates/times of discharge

Details of discharge

Root cause

Actual/probable fate of pollution

Remedial actions taken

Procedures to prevent reoccurrence
